SAFETY PROTOCOL FOR HOMETOWN THROWDOWN BBQ TEAMS

The EffingHAM-JAM committee has established the following guidelines for professional teams to be in compliance with the Effingham County Health Department. ******These guidelines are subject to change/cancellation.***

- Teams will be placed at least 6 feet apart.
- Sneeze guards will be required to separate team from audience
- Food samples are placed in individual serving cups for distribution to the participants and placed on the table to then be picked up by audience.
- X's will be placed on the roadway and/or sidewalk to ensure proper social distancing.
- Per state requirement, 1 person in each team must receive a State of Illinois food handler license.
- All teams are required to assign 1 team member to wear gloves when serving the food samples.
- Cooking & serving surfaces must be sanitized every 15 minutes.
